
Some epistemological foundations

Need to define some basic terms and concepts:


- Region, Territory (identity, borders)
- Proximity (spatial, temporal, social)
- Development (economic, quality of life)

Through some approaches:

- Proxemic
- Topological field



Proxemic




Human adaptation to places and spaces (Zipf "least effort)"
Each individual acts in a spatial and temporal world (mental, values)

Leads to research of the topological field: values of places taking into account the closest as opposed to the outside (Moles "human shells")


